#### **Ohio State Reformatory**

Once used to reform young offenders in the late 1880's, the massive building stands with large granite pillars & elegant construction. Comprised of 250,000 sq. ft. & combining three architectural styles: *Victorian Gothic, Richardsonian Romanesque & Queen Anne.* One of the biggest castle-like structures in the U.S. & one of the top 5 largest. The Reformatory houses the world's tallest free-standing steel cell block. **\$9p/p**. April 1-Sept. 1.

#### Squirrel's Den
