- Discovering exotic plants in the Display Greenhouse or a literary adventure on the Storybook Trail
- Visiting our current exhibits, "The Story of Kingwood" and "Elegant Entertaining"

## Kingwood Hall

A Kingwood docent will lead you room by room through the majestic Kingwood Hall, listed on the national register of historic places.



## Grounds & Gardens

Journey through the gardens with a horticulture expert. Learn about our historic gardens, plants of interest, and other unique features.



## Fountains & Statues

Interested in art and history? On this tour through the grounds, your group will explore Kingwood's many statues, fountains, and other landmarks.



## Behind the Scenes

Visit locations not typically accessed by the public. From Kingwood Hall's attic to the horticulture production areas, this tour will give you a unique perspective on what makes Kingwood special.



## Townsend House

Take a journey back in time while you explore another mansion at Kingwood, the Townsend House. Located across from our main grounds, you'll discover the unique history behind this beautiful home.



## Golf Cart Tours

A guide will escort you on a tour of the gardens from the comfort of one of our golf carts. Our golf cart tours accommodate 1 to 7 guests and have a flat fee of \$75. Please note, all other venues, other than the grounds and gardens, are self-guided with this option.



## School Groups

School groups, including home school and college groups, receive free self-guided group visits during approved times on weekdays only. Advanced registration is required. A Kingwood-themed scavenger hunt is included with all school group visits if requested.

Guided tours of Kingwood Hall, the Grounds and Gardens, or Statues and Fountains is available for \$4 per student (teachers and chaperones are free but must still be included with group count). Please note, Townsend and Behind the Scenes tours are not available for school groups younger than 16.

School groups can pack lunches or purchase a boxed lunch option. Advanced notice is required for the boxed lunch option. School groups may eat outdoors or inside the service room at Kingwood Hall depending on availability.



## Shopping & Dining

Our new visitor center, the Garden Gateway is home to both the Garden & Gift Shop and the Gateway Café! While visiting the Gateway Café, make sure to treat yourself to lunch, coffee, or a snack! In our Garden & Gift Shop, you can enjoy shopping for unique gifts, garden accessories, and quality plants to take home your own piece of Kingwood.

- No group tours are available on Saturdays
- Group rates are unavailable for events such as Christmas at Kingwood
- All group tours must be scheduled at least two weeks prior to tour date
- Tours may be refunded if cancelled at least 3 business days in advance
- A 50% deposit is required at the time of reservation
