

One of America's most haunted prisons! Search the rows of stacked cells, solitary confinement, and creepy corridors in this castle-like 1896 former prison. Ghost Hunts, Ghost Walks, classes and events, and private paranormal investigations are known to document continuous activity.

Used in a number of films including *The Shawshank Redemption*, *Air Force One* and *Escape Plan: The Extractors*.

Haunted Bissman Building

In 1886, the Bissman Building was designed by the same architect who drew up plans for the Ohio State Reformatory and became a successful wholesale grocery business. Experienced ghost hunters report that when the company closed its doors, "Not all of the employees left the building." Guides unveil its unique history, share stories of movies and videos filmed on site, and reveal chilling tales of black masses, shadow figures, cold spots and ghostly spirits, including that of a former employee decapitated in the elevator.


Mansfield Fire Museum

Once known as a 'hangout' (lil' Capone's), this museum now is dedicated to collecting and preserving fire trucks, artifacts, history & traditions of firefighting.

Perhaps it's the artifacts that make the spirits come alive. Both employees and visitors have experienced a fire truck side mirror that appears to move on its own. Unexplained sounds when only one person is in the building, lights that flicker, and shadowy figures of unknown people have been reported during paranormal investigations.

Experience America's most famous farm, the 900-acre country estate of Louis Bromfield who was a Pulitzer Prize winning author, farmer, and pioneer in innovative scientific farming concepts.

Ghostly sightings have been reported by staff and visitors alike at historic Malabar Farm's Big House. Tales of flickering lights and appearances by the ghost of Louis Bromfield—and his beloved boxer dogs—intrigue ghost hunters.

The Renaissance Theatre opened as a movie palace in 1928 and is now a showcase for performing arts & entertainment, but also known for ghostly encounters. Footsteps have been heard coming from the grand staircase, dark hallways, and balcony. Disembodied voices have been heard in the projection booth and whispering in the catacomb-like rooms under the stage and lobby where a 1929 murder took place.

Built in the first decade of the 20th century by one of Galion's founding families, the Gill House was designed by a nationally-recognized architect. The original owners of the 6,000 sq. ft. home, Bloomer and Nellie Gill, were associated with the early automobile industry and were visited by family friends Thomas Alva Edison and Henry Ford.

Footsteps, laughter, physical contact, traveling shadows, and full body apparitions have been witnessed by both visitors and volunteers from the around the US and Canada.
